## MEET THE FAMILY

OUR FAMILY'S WINE HISTORY DATES BACK TO I 883 IN ISCHIA, ITALY AND MY GREAT GRANDFATHER, SALVATORE DOMINIC SCOTTO. IN I 903, DOMINIC AND HIS FAMILY IMMIGRATED TO NEW YORK AND SETTLED IN A BROOKLYN BROWNSTONE, NOT FAR FROM THE DOCKS WHERE HE WORKED AS A SHIP'S CAULKER. HE TAUGHT HIS SONS TO MAKE AND SELL WINE, AND THEY EVENTUALLY OPENED SCOTTO'S WINE CELLARS; IT'S STILL A BROOKLYN NEIGHBORHOOD LANDMARK, AS WE SAW WHEN WE VISITED RECENTLY.

MY GRANDFATHER ANTHONY'S CAREER STARTED IN I 940 WHEN HE BEGAN SELLING GALLON JUGS OF HIS FATHER'S HOMEMADE RED WINE FROM A PUSH-CART. HE AND HIS OLDEST BROTHER SAL ALSO CREATED VILLA ARMANDO, WHICH THEY CALLED "RUSTICO," THE ITALIAN WORD FOR RUSTIC. TODAY IT'S ONE OF THE OLDEST WINE BRANDS IN THE U.S. AND HAS FILLED MORE THAN 250,000,000 GLASSES WITH TRADITIONAL RED WINE.
